











Logging in to **Schoology** for the first time (students)

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Open up a web browser (like Chrome) on any device, and go to the sd129.org website. 2. In the SD129 website menu, find and click on the STUDENTS option. (You may need to click on the menu icon ☰ or resize your screen)
